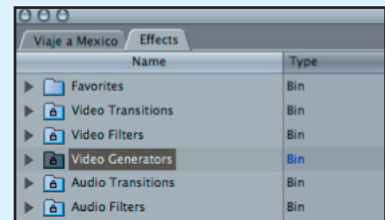


What is a SUGARfx Theme in FCP ?

A SUGARfx Theme is a collection of Video Generator elements that provide an animated way to enhance the look of your edited piece as it is usually done in a professional environment using Motion Graphics Animations.

A themes usually contains elements that enhance and unify the look of your edited program, like an Open or Close, Bumpers, Lower thirds and other elements. They are usually animated sequences that adorn the important parts of your editorial.

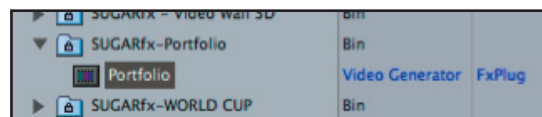

How to use it.

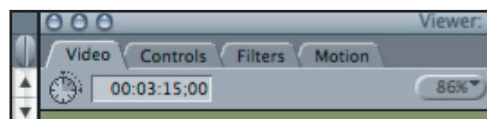
In FCP go to the Effects tab Video Generators and select the theme folder you want to use. Open it and select the element of your choice, and drag it into the timeline of your sequence.



Double-click the element in the timeline, so you can edit its parameters in the **Viewer** window.

Viewer Window > Video Tab

The Video tab will show you how the element looks and you can hit the “play” button to see a real time playback of it. You can adjust the duration as if it was a regular movie element.



Viewer Window > Controls Tab

The Controls Tab gives shows the available parameters that you can change for the element that you are using. Control parameters are usually different for all elements.

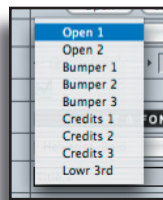

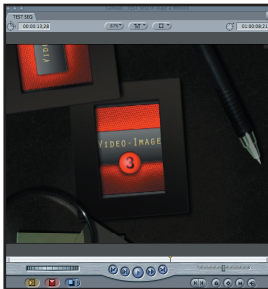
Element selection



Set the duration of your element in "seconds"

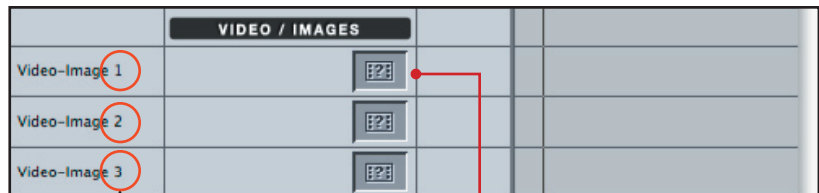
Font options and Text Titles
